

Emergency Delays or Closure Details

Depending on weather conditions or other emergency situations, a decision may be made regarding school closures or delays. PVS will decide on one of the plans listed below, but if weather conditions worsen, a 2-hour delay could be changed to a school closure day.

Please monitor the PVS website, <u>www.pvschool.com</u>, our school Facebook page, <u>www.facebook.com/prescottvalleycharter</u>, and check for an email and/or phone call for up to date information.

Plan 1: School Closure Day

Students and employees will stay home and not attend school. Extra-curricular activities scheduled will be cancelled as well.

Plan 2: Two-Hour Delay Schedule

General Information:

- All schedules will begin two (2) hours later.
- Regular classes will begin two hours later than usual.
- Buses will arrive at the bus stops two (2) hours later than usual. (For example, a bus pick-up time of 6:35 a.m. becomes an 8:35 a.m. pick-up time.)
- Dismissal of school in the afternoon will be at the regular time.
- Breakfast will NOT be served on 2-Hour delay days
- There is NO before school care on 2-Hour delay days

Decisions to close or not to close school are made very early in the morning, before daylight based on overall safety and road conditions. Be assured that any decision to close or delay school is carefully considered and made only after evaluating all available up-to-date information and reports. Your cooperation with these plans will be greatly appreciated.

NOTE: In the unlikely event of an early dismissal due to inclement weather, or campus emergency parents will be required to pick up their student(s) from school. Students will not be released before the regular dismissal time unless absolutely necessary. There will NOT be after school care in the event of an early dismissal and bus routes may be cancelled if weather is severe.
